VINTAGE CLUB NERO D'AVOLA

TASTING NOTES

Plaga Nero D'Avola is bold, fruity and powerful, with a ruby-red colour reminiscent of young Italian wines. A complex aroma blends red fruits such as berries and plums, with hints of black pepper and spices. Oak-aging introduces memories of vanilla and coffee. Young, fruity and soft on the palate, a delicate wine with good structure, and a taste that is fresh, round and well balanced. A friendly wine with a long pleasant finish.



TECHNICAL NOTES

Origin: 50% Nero D'Avola
50% Merlot Italy Sicily
Fermentation: 14 days with French yeast at temperature of 18 degrees Celsius.
Aged: Nine months in contact with American Oak and French oak.
Alcohol: 12,8%
Vintage: 2016

OCCASION

A bottle of Nero D'Avola is the perfect compliment to a hearty meal, whether a rich and savoury beef rendang, a juicy rump steak or a spicy pasta arrabiata. It also combines beautifully with desserts, especially those made with chocolate and cinnamon.

VINIFICATION

Plaga wines are made under the same parameters of vinification as prestigious vineyards in Australia, Chile and California. The fermentation process occurs under low temperatures using stainless steel tanks, pipes and pumps in order to preserve and extract the highest quality juice from imported grapes. In the stabilisation, clarification and filtration stages we have used only first quality enological product from overseas, assuring the quality of our products. The bottling process has been made in a special Italian bottling line to ensure a perfect seal and the correct evolution of the wine in bottle. Time, dedication and the most modern technology are an essential part of the vinification of each bottle of Plaga Wine.

DESCRIPTION

Plaga Magnum is a European style red wine, with high maturation and a radical concept of aging, to give complexity and follow the evolution to enrich the wine. You can feel a big body and a right freshness in a 18 months wine with very complex aroma and strong palate. Color: Red - Ruby color already with slightly evolution. Aroma: Very complex aromas from the high maturation and aging. Candied plums, smoked oak and balsamic hints are the most relevant, with other touches from American oaks and primary aromas from Nero D'Avola. Palate: A big structure with strong character balances all the Nero D'Avola and Merlot characteristics. Dark plums and balsamic notes persist in a long after taste feeling with an appealing baked cake entrance.
